Estimated time (including stops) : two hours

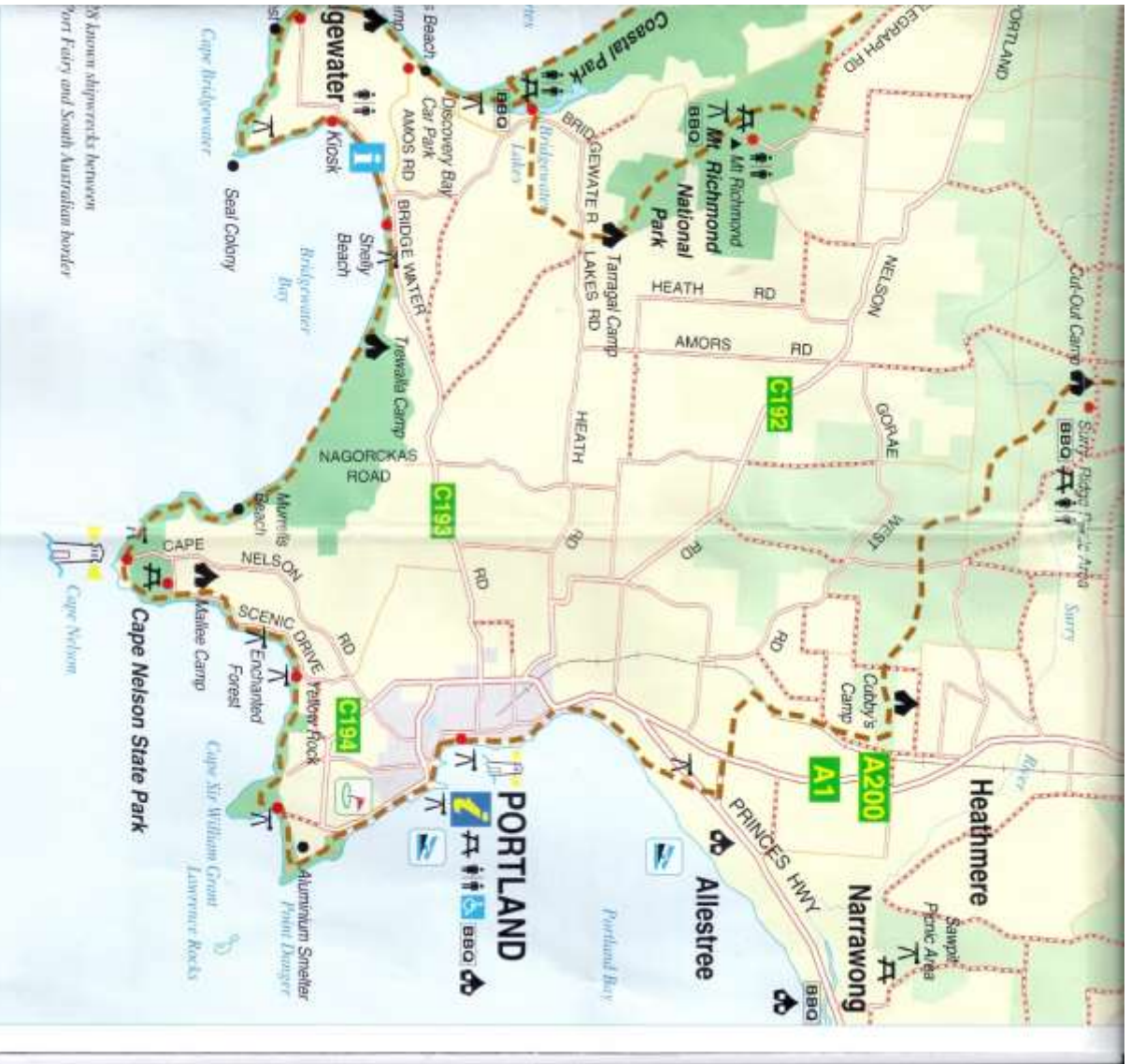
Transport from the Lodge : drive to Mount Richmond picnic ground (30km).
