GREAT SOUTH WEST WALK – ANNUAL WEEK AWAY 2018

Date : Thursday, April 19

Walk Name : Glenelg River Gorge (Weeping Rock to Lasletts Canoe Camp)

Walk Leader (Group A) : _____

Distance : 16km

Estimated time (including stops) : five hours

Transport from the Lodge : drop car(s) off at Lasletts (70km), then drive to the start at Weeping Rock (located between Forest Camp and Murrells, 20km back towards Portland).

Description : This walk takes in some of the best sections of the Glenelg River Gorge. Excellent riverine scenery, enhanced by the azure blue of the partially saline waters of the river. Note that the river water is somewhat unpalatable (due to its salinity) and most people would not drink it by choice.

Given the distance from Portland, and the long-ish car shuttle, we could divide the group into two parties, one starting at Weeping Rock, the other at Lasletts, and swap car keys at the mid-point. We successfully used this MO on the Lighthouse-to-Lighthouse Walk at Eden.

AWTGS : Grade 3, poles recommended.

Estimated time (including stops) : three hours

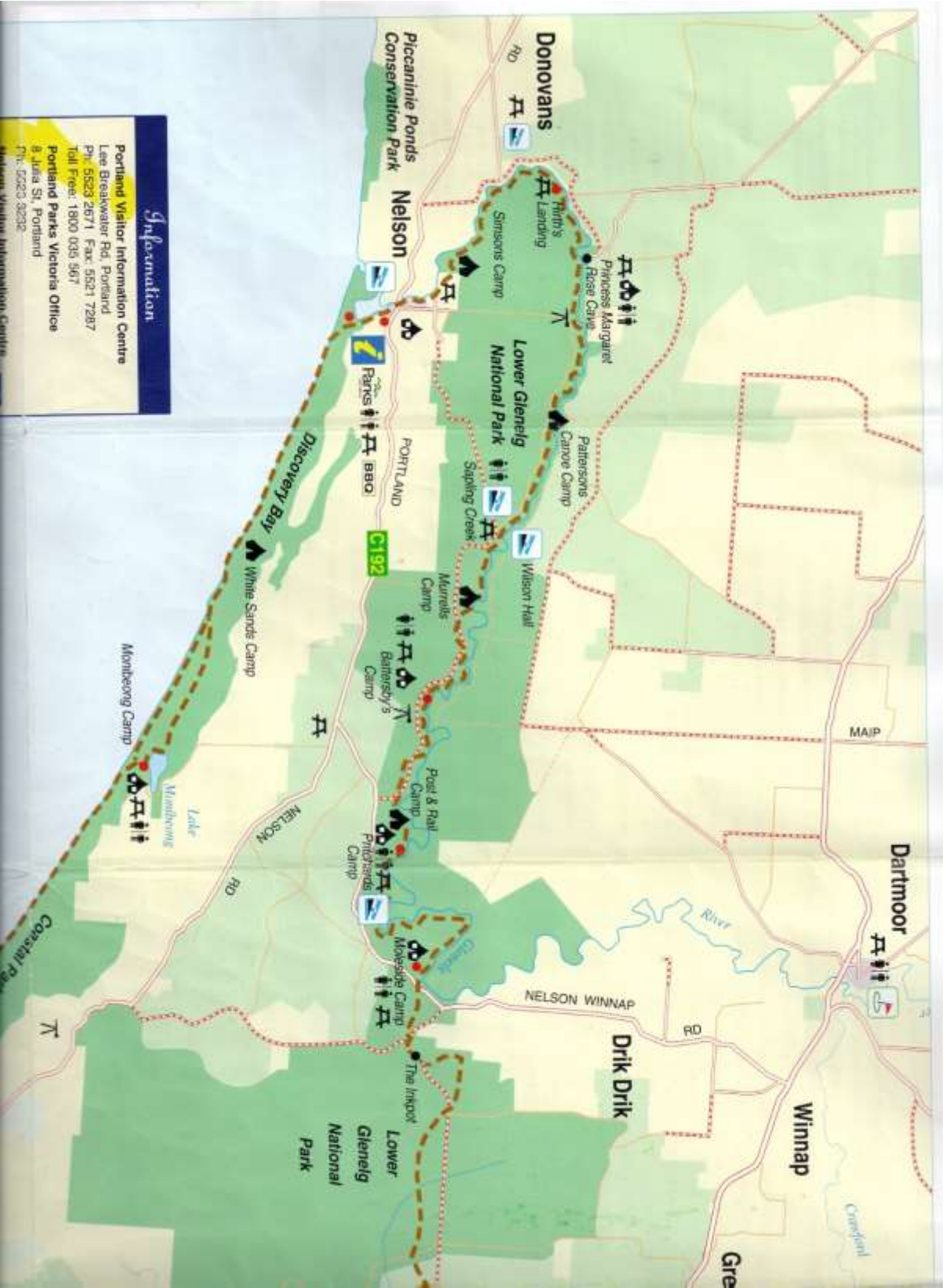
Transport from the Lodge : drive to Moleside Landing, about 20km.
