GREAT SOUTH WEST WALK – ANNUAL WEEK AWAY 2018

Date : Wednesday, April 18

Walk Name : This is notionally our rest day, but for those who want to complete some more sections of the GSWW, we could tackle a fern gully walk (one of the most westerly in Australia).

Walk Leader : _____

Distance : 6km

Estimated time (including stops) : two hours

Transport from the Lodge : drive to Jackass Fern Gully (26km)

Description : This loop walk takes in some of the fern gully sections of the GSWW, as well as Mount Van Dyke, and is within Cobboboonee National Park.

AWTGS : Grade 3.

Estimated time (including stops) : about 1.25hrs for each walk.

Transport from the Lodge : drive to the southern side of the Portland urban area (about 5km).
